Around The World Cultural Fair Guidelines:

- You must be a Round Meadow student (grades TK-5) to participate.
- This is not a drop-off event. Children must be accompanied by a parent.
- Students may work together.
- Groups may be combined based on interest.
- Please use batteries and Bluetooth speakers if you are playing music.
- If you need access to electricity, you must inform us in the sign-up form.
- Food must be served cold or warmed up prior to the event.
- No nuts or peanuts.
- Any booth serving food must have an adult present who can read the ingredients list to younger children.
- Food portion sizes are limited to Costco sample sizes.
- Food samples may need to be setup in an adjacent area depending on space availability.
- All project materials must be cleaned up and taken home at the end of the event.
