### *Principal report:*

### *Treasurers Report:*

- \$156 K in YES fund
- Expensive, LVUSD specialist the most expensive, and separate STEAM program, and teacher, and educational subscriptions.
- \$112 K to date
- \$87 K on income with significant installments to pay overtime for the specialists.

### *Updates:*

- Stop spending and reduce the spending until we come back on campus
- Commitment to specialists end on Jan 29<sup>th</sup> End of PE, music, and art. PE is still provided through recorded piece through the District.
- Will provide Spring Social Art Haus art class (mix of live and recorded), start around Feb meeting.
- Enrollment is down and will be part of next conversations
- Rebuilding with an eye towards sustainability
- Spirit wear: relaunch of materials, made about \$500 and more orders coming in from—lots of new stuff and different colors.
- Runya—thank you for the room parents and zoom parents and the holiday parties. Kids enjoyed and appreciated it.

- Cristi, Yearbook: keep send pictures, need around Halloween, need back to school for 3<sup>rd</sup> grade, Update in the next week on the upcoming week pictures, call for all the pictures because need outside pictures.

*Open the Floor:*

- Valentines day question: Hot Coco bombs for Valentines day. Exchange of Valentines? Try to coordinate with the pick-ups? Coordinate with the teachers.
- Next Years PFA board—need to coordinate with leadership. Next meeting more discussions
  - Open positions from the Ex Board meeting with the positions—in the next 10 days.
- Closing and reopening: Gov idea as long as there are a lot of benchmarks met. All schools through 6<sup>th</sup> grade at Feb 16—change in administration and funding. Also still depends on LA County guidance and policy. Expect more information in the next weeks. Bring back TK-3 and repeat for 4-5<sup>th</sup> grade students.
- Staff vaccine—LVUSD health clerk and nurses got the vaccine, LVUSD trying to get the vaccine quickly. Declaration of 1b for the vaccine as educators. Waiting for county to declare 1b level.
- Would be bringing back 4 and 5<sup>th</sup> grade at the same time—expand to TK-6<sup>th</sup>. Any school can have 25% for specialized programs, youngest learners. RME could bring TK-2 with waiver.
- Cohort size is capped at 12—would have to expand the cohort size for 4-5<sup>th</sup> grade, desk 6<sup>th</sup> feet apart to determine the number of desks.
- No set guidance on when to bring the 4-5<sup>th</sup> based on TK-3 return. Many schools are doing a rolling bring back. Make sure that all the kids doing a return to campus walkthrough.
- Have not heard anything about 7-12 return to campus—LA county, TK-6 bring back is main focus.
- Goal to return TK-3 by Feb 1.
- Not sure of the TK-6 return to campus process.
- Superintendent call with county on Thursdays, so more information coming out.
